Whilst delivering the very best hospital-based services for the people it serves, the BOPDHB (in combination with its healthcare partners throughout the Bay of Plenty health system) is also continuing its journey towards providing more community-based health services.

Fundamental to this work is the BOPDHB's Strategic Health Services Plan (SHSP) 2017-27, which establishes the key areas of focus over the 10 years to 2027.

The SHSP's three strategic objectives are:

- 1. Live well Empower Bay of Plenty populations to live healthy lives
- 2. Stay well Develop a smart, fully integrated system to provide care close to where people live, learn, work and play
- 3. Get well Evolve models of excellence across all hospital services

The SHSP has been designed to meet the changing health needs of the Bay's communities and was developed with input from BOPDHB staff; community-based health services, other support agencies and patient advocates. It has an emphasis on improving the way hospital services and health services provided in the community work together.

At the heart of this plan are the patient, families and whanau. The overarching aim is for people to get well, stay well and live well. To achieve this, the plan has a strengthened focus on providing integrated health services, bringing health services closer to the patient, and providing the right mix of health supports in the right place.

It will help provide health services that better support people to stay well and manage their own health, and for people to be empowered to live healthy lives.

Health services can be diverse and complex, and ensuring people can navigate the Bay of Plenty health services system is an important part of them managing their own wellbeing. A health services directory plays a key role in supporting this and www.healthpoint.co.nz has been adopted for this purpose.

Over the coming weeks, Healthpoint will map the Bay's healthcare services and support providers to profile and publish rich, comprehensive information about who and where they are, the services they provide, and how to access them.

With the profiling of many services in the Bay of Plenty, both referrers and the general public will access Healthpoint as their main source to find healthcare services.





Treating Symptomatic Aortic Stenosis

Symptomatic aortic stenosis is a serious condition with a 50% two-year mortality without valve replacement. The aortic valve can now be replaced percutaneously (TAVI) under conscious sedation at a lower risk of death and stroke and much faster recovery than after conventional surgical replacement in most people.



Right Upper Sternal Border





Listen to the chest and if there is a systolic murmur refer to a cardiologist

If appropriate, the cardiologist may refer the patient to the Intra Heart Team for TAVI consideration, or if unsuitable, potentially for cardiac surgery. Most insurance companies now reimburse TAVI.



Universe strives to deliver a complete package of care through clinical excellence, compassion, and patient education and empowerment. He is fluent in Cantonese and proficient in Mandarin.



Salve provides:


- Appointment and treatment info and reminders


